

Lieutenant Colonel Carl H. Farley assumed command of the 1st Bn 138th Regional Training Institute (GS) on August 1st, 2011. As the Commander of the RTI, Lieutenant Colonel Farley's primary focus is to lead the RTI in all training development ventures. Lieutenant Colonel Farley began his career as an enlisted soldier for the Army National Guard in 1980. He was commissioned as a Second Lieutenant, Finance Branch, in May 1990 after graduating from the Indiana Military Academy.

Prior to receiving Command of the 138th RTI, Lieutenant Colonel Farley held numerous positions within the Indiana Army National Guard. Lieutenant Colonel Farley returned from Afghanistan to serve as the G8 Resource Manager for the 38th Infantry Division.
