Conratulations on your tour! - Please read and follow the procedures below to ensue an efficient redeployment: **If you are CEW or MoDA, your DEMOB station is Camp Atterbury, IN**

*** MoDA/CEW redeployers make commercial travel to Indianapolis from the point where the MILAIR Flight ports first in the states. This needs to be completed at the Kuwait SATO office.**

Weapons: If you are returning with weapon, we have to secure the weapon when you arrive:

1. Let us know if you are returning with a weapon
2. Account for the weapon each time you do a baggage check
3. GOV transportation only with weapons-no rentals, POVs, or taxis (Redeployment LNO will pick you up).

Typical DEMOB schedule:

SATURDAY: If you arrive on a Saturday please contact **Redeployment** by phone, text, or email in order to notify us of your arrival. You can reach him at **812-344-1076** or redeployment@mckellarcorporation.com . Please include your name, CEW or MoDA, if you have a weapon, and GS level.

SUNDAY: Return to the airport no later than 12:00 in order to be transported to Camp Atterbury. A POC will be stationed at the airport in the baggage claim area to facilitate your move to Camp Atterbury.

When you arrive at CA you will be issued a room for the evening. All of your turn in gear will be staged in building 353 and weapons will be stored in the weapons storage vault until the next morning. If you have not completed your Post Deployment Health Assessment (PDHA) within the last 30 days you will be asked to complete it at this time. You have the option of completing your medical screening here or you may do it at your home station.

MONDAY: At the designated time given, please clear your room and turn in your room key to the redeployment LNO. Travel arrangement to your home will be made later this day. If you are unable to get a flight out a new room will be provided for the evening.

Medical: All CEW/ MoDA deciding to complete medical will be taken to the medical processing station and your Medical LNO will usher you through the process.

CIF: All issued gear will be collected at this time. If any gear is missing you will be issued a statement of charges. You have 30 days in order to buy a money order and mail it to the address you will be provided. If you are not missing any gear, you will be provided with a cleared hand receipt.

SATO: Travel arrangements will be made through SATO. You will need your government travel card and a copy of your orders. Please confirm that your government travel card is active by calling the number located on the back of your card. Be sure to listen to the entire message before hanging up. Due to inactivity the card may have been deactivated or put on a hold status. Once your travel itinerary has been confirmed you will be transported back to the airport for your flight home.
