Colonel Lee Baker assumed command of the 138th Regional Training Institute on 1 September 2011. As the Commander of the RTI, Colonel Baker's primary focus is to lead the RTI in all training development ventures.

Colonel Baker began his career in 1982 when he enlisted in the Mississippi Army National Guard and attended Basic Training at Fort Sill, OK. Upon returning from Basic Training he enrolled in the University of Southern Mississippi Army ROTC and joined the Simultaneous Membership. In 1984 he was commissioned as a 2LT in Military Intelligence and assigned to the 31st Rear Area Operations Center in Jackson, MS. He completed his undergraduate degree in 1986 and started serving on Active Duty.

Prior to receiving Command of the 138th RTI, Colonel Baker held numerous positions within the Indiana Army National Guard. Colonel Baker's operational assignments include G2 Operations Officer, 38th Infantry Division, G2 Operations Officer, 38th Infantry Division (forward) during Operation Joint Forge in Bosnia, Commander, 638th Military Intelligence Battalion, Executive Officer, Regional Police Advisor, Afghanistan. Colonel Baker has also served as Professor of Military Science, Ball State University. Colonel Baker is currently AGR serving as Director, Army Personnel for Indiana Joint Force Headquarters in Indianapolis.
