## **Camp Atterbury to hold Community Day**

**EDINBURGH, Ind.** – Camp Atterbury is hosting its 2nd Annual Community Day event scheduled for Saturday, August 27, at 10 a.m. This year’s event will kick off at the Veterans Memorial Wall with a welcoming ceremony and tribute to service members and veterans that have deployed through Camp Atterbury and Muscatatuck since World War II.
