



## Atterbury Conference Center (ACC)

The Atterbury Conference Center, dedicated in 2011, is a 10,000 sq. ft. structure, built of logs from Montana, and stands adjacent to the MG Carl G. Farrell Recreation Area. The ACC is a multi-purpose

facility, maintained to fulfill important functions as part of Camp Atterbury operations. It is considered a top-notch facility for official meetings, conferences and functions for the Indiana National Guard and other state and federal agencies.

**Conference Center Facilities:** The ACC main building can be configured to accommodate a variety of conferences, meetings and unofficial social functions.

### Facilities include:

- **Great Hall:** This beautiful 5,800 sq. ft. hall can seat 300 when configured auditorium style, about 150 in a classroom setup and 200 for dinner or banquet setup.
- **Meeting/Conference Rooms:** The ACC a meeting rooms, 250 sq. ft. for small breakout meetings, with seating 12 – 15.
- **Social / Reception Area:** This beautiful 2600 sq. ft. hall features an imposing stone fireplace and is adorned with crests of units previously mobilized at Camp Atterbury from World War II thru Desert Storm / Desert Shield. The hall also features a social area that will hold about 160 people for a social gathering. Serviced by a counter/bar area.
- **Patios:** A veranda adjoins the main Hall with seating and small gathering areas, as well as a large fire pit.
- **Other:** 8 individual restrooms; warming kitchen for the caterer.
- **Parking:** Paved parking for 100 vehicles is available adjacent to the Center.
