**EDINBURGH, Ind.** – U. S. Army North, U. S. Northern Command's Joint Force Land Component Command, will host about 5,500 military and civilian personnel from across the country to take part in a major training exercise simulating the response to a terrorist attack in the United States.

Exercise Vibrant Response, the nation's premier disaster response exercise, will take place July 21 - Aug. 7 at Camp Atterbury, Ind., and surrounding areas. There will be increased military convoy traffic in the vicinity of Atterbury and Muscatatuck from units participating in the Vibrant Response exercise, July 21 – Aug. 7.
