Roudebush VA Medical Center health care system has recently opened the Wakeman healthcare clinic at Camp Atterbury. A formal dedication ceremony for the clinic open to all Veterans, their families and the public will be held on March 30th at 11 AM. The clinic unites the mission of Veteran Health Care and the Indiana National Guard. This cooperative venture brings health care closer to home for rural south Central Indiana Veterans.

All Veterans are welcome at the Wakeman clinic; Veterans currently not receiving health care benefits they have earned; Veterans currently enrolled at the Indianapolis VA and Veterans enrolled in any other VA in the United States are eligible for treatment at the Wakeman Clinic Camp Atterbury.
